Tone Tubes

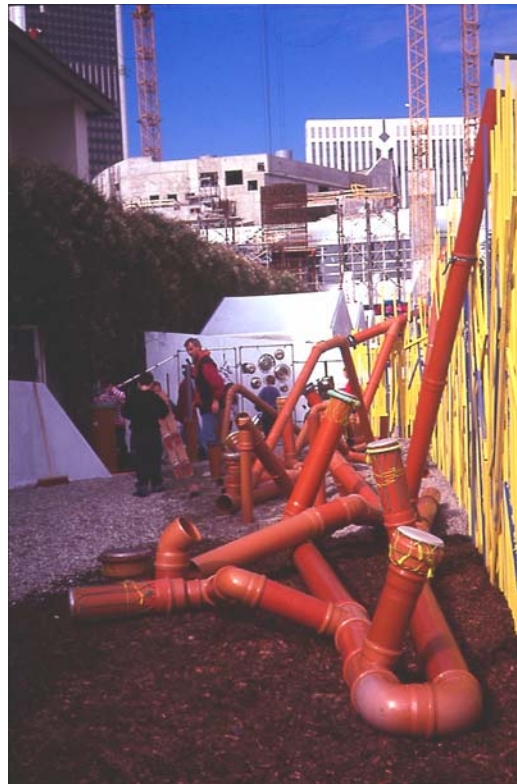
The mobile musical construction site



25 drums with a diameter from 20 to 50 cm, 6 pump-pipes, 10 tubular-bells, a 5 meter long flute, giant slam-on and several „call-in“ and „listen-to“-pipes. The Tone Tubes consists of 80 metres orange-coloured plastic pipes.

These pipes form an always changing, huge, sounding pipe-system with the help of many junctions. This labyrinth of sound sculptures satisfies not only the kids but also their fathers.

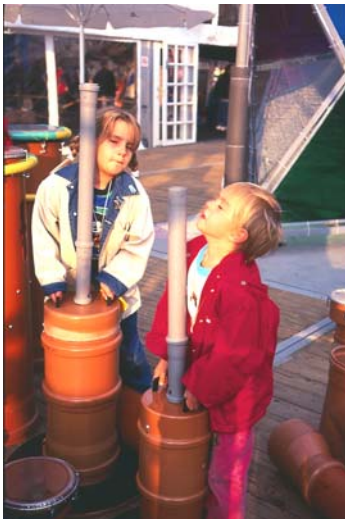
The sculpture is still growing and each year new instruments are built.

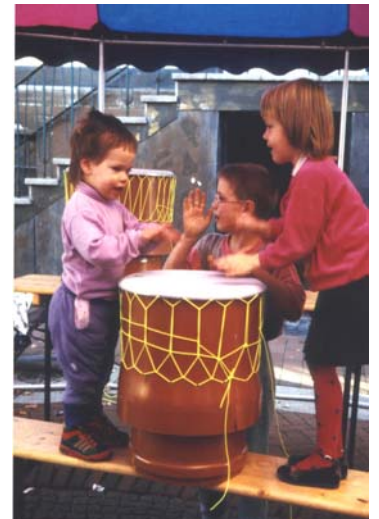
Pump-Pipes, Stern für Kids 1995
